INTONACHINO ARGILLA CARE & MAINTENANCE

Everyday care

- Marks & smudges: Simply use a barely damp natural sponge and gently wipe the affected area in circular motions. Allow to dry naturally.
- Avoid over-wetting: Excess moisture can soften the plaster temporarily; always use a lightly damp sponge rather than a wet cloth.
- Do not use detergents, soaps, vinegar, or chemical cleaners. These may damage or discolour the natural clay.

Minor scratches or scuffs

- Most light scratches can be sponged out using a barely damp sponge.
- The surface can be lightly re-burnished by hand once dry to restore the original sheen and tone.

Stains

- Act quickly. Sponge out stains as soon as possible after they occur.
- If a mark remains, lightly remove the affected plaster and reapply a small amount of Intonachino Argilla to the area once dry.

Long-term maintenance

- If required, entire areas can be refreshed by applying a new thin coat of clay plaster or by gently misting and re-trowelling the surface.

Professional repairs

- For larger repairs or to refresh entire walls, contact your applicator to ensure correct colour and texture matching.

Environmental considerations

- Clay plasters are breathable and should not be sealed with acrylic paints or synthetic coatings.
- Avoid prolonged exposure to direct water or continuous humidity (such as in showers or near kitchen splash zones).
- Maintain stable indoor conditions where possible; extreme humidity or condensation may temporarily darken the surface until dry.

Warranty information

- Intonachino Argilla is covered by a 5-year warranty against flaking, blistering, or peeling provided it has been applied by trained professionals following the application techniques and systems specified by Beri Calce.
